As a discussion based class, the instructor had that rare ability to foster participation in class without having to call on someone to answer any of the questions. Another tricky aspect of this kind of literature-heavy course for most instructors is to ensure that all students were keeping up on the daily readings. Dr. Knight utilized a creative daily journal assignment system in which each student was to hand in their personal reflections on a specific point on the day's reading. I found this strategy to stimulate more genuine thinking while studying literature rather than the comparatively hollow concept of stressful quizzes. Choosing many short works over a few drawn out ones helped the students refresh their minds on a weekly basis and helped keep the classroom discussion fresh.
